Required Duties of Den Chief:

- Serve as the activities assistant at den meetings.
- Meet regularly with the den leader to review the den and pack meeting plans.
- If serving as a Webelos den chief; help prepare boys to join Boy Scouting.
- Project a positive image of Boy Scouting.
- Set a good example.
- Wear the Scout uniform correctly.
- Live by the Scout Oath and Scout Law.
- Show and help develop Scout spirit.

Additional Guidelines Assigned by Troop:

- Participate in ILST Training
- Complete Den Chief Training, Online or Formal Classroom
- Lead a Webelos den at a Troop activity.
- If the pack has a "Bridging to Boy Scouting" ceremony, participate with the event and invite the Troop to this event.

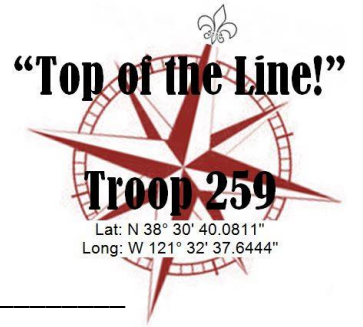
