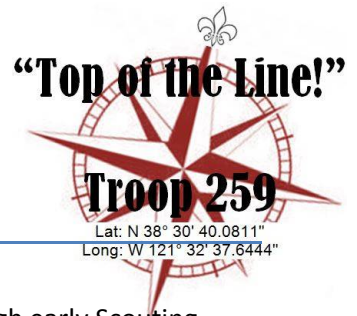

Troop Guide



Job Description:

The troop guide introduces new Scouts to troop operations and guides them through early Scouting activities. He serves as a coach to the patrol leader of the new-Scout patrol and works with him at patrol leaders' council meetings. He helps new Scouts earn the First Class rank within their first 12 to 18 months. The troop guide is not a member of another patrol but may participate in the high-adventure activities of a Venture patrol.

Position Coordinator: Assistant Scoutmaster of Trail to First Class (TtFC)

Qualifications: First Class (usually one of the older Scouts)
Scoutmaster approval

Required Duties of Troop Guide:

- Introduces new Scouts to troop operations.
- Guides new Scouts from harassment by older Scouts.
- Helps new Scouts earn First Class rank in their first year. (Trail to First Class)
- Teaches basic Scout skills.
- Coaches the patrol leader of the new-Scout patrol on his duties.
- Works with the patrol leader at patrol leaders' council meetings.
- Attends patrol leaders' council meetings with the patrol leader of the new-Scout patrol.
- Assists the assistant Scoutmaster with training.
- Counsels individuals Scouts on Scouting challenges.
- Sets a good example.
- Enthusiastically and correctly wears the Scout uniform (all four parts).
- Lives by the Scout Oath and Law.
- Shows Scout spirit

Additional Guidelines Assigned by Troop:

- Assist the ASPL with providing ILST training
- Provides Leadership to at least 1 (one) Trail to First Class event monthly that results in a requirement completion.
- Assist assigned scouts in site selection and set-up at all outings.
- Check in with assigned scouts during meal preparation and breaking camp to ensure everything is going well.
- Consider participation in a NYLT course.
- Promote the NYLT course within the troop.

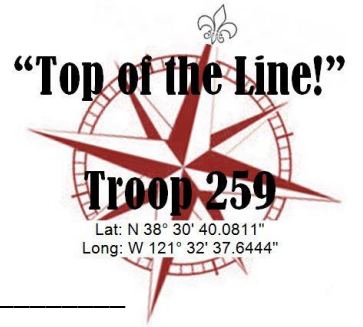
